1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work efficiently, provide a better browsing experience, and send analytical information to the site owners.

2. How We Use Cookies

We use cookies to enhance your experience on our website by:

- * Keeping you logged into your training portal or booking account.
- * Remembering items you add to your shopping basket while retailing first aid kits.
- * Understanding how visitors navigate our site so we can improve our course and product layouts.
- * Ensuring the security of your online transactions and payment processing.

3. Types of Cookies We Use

We categorise our cookies into the following types:

A. Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for our website to function properly. Without them, core services like the shopping basket for first aid kits, secure checkout, or course booking systems cannot be provided.

Consent Required: No. These are vital for contract fulfilment.

B. Analytical and Performance Cookies

These cookies collect data on how visitors interact with our website. They help us count page visits, monitor website speed, and see which first aid courses or retail kits are the most popular. All data collected is aggregated and anonymous.

Consent Required: Yes. Managed via our cookie banner.

C. Functional Cookies

These cookies allow our website to remember choices you make (such as your username, language, or geographical region) to provide a more personalised online experience.

Consent Required: Yes. Managed via our cookie banner.

D. Targeting and Advertising Cookies

These cookies track your browsing habits across websites to deliver advertisements that are more relevant to your professional training or safety equipment needs. They are also used to limit the number of times you see an advert and measure marketing campaign efficiency.

Consent Required: Yes. Managed via our cookie banner.

4. Third-Party Cookies

In addition to our own cookies, trusted third parties may also drop cookies on your device through our website. These include:

Payment Gateways: Secure third-party processors (e.g., Stripe, PayPal) to handle payments for first aid training and kits safely.

Analytics Providers: Services like Google Analytics to evaluate web traffic trends and site health.

* **Booking Software:** Integrated platforms managing live training calendar slots and seat availability.

5. Managing and Controlling Cookies

Web Browser Settings

You can block or delete cookies directly through your internet browser settings.

However, restricting strictly necessary cookies will prevent you from booking training courses or purchasing first aid products on our site.
